

WHAT TO BRING

(Note: Dorm room space is limited; you will be sharing your room with one or more roommates)

Things to bring:

Prepaid phone cards	Laundry basket
Sheets (twin size) and pillowcases	Throw rug
Mattress pad	Pictures or posters
Blankets	Mug, bowl, plate, silverware for dorm use
Pillow	Dictionary
Towels and washcloths	Calculator
Shower basket for shampoo, soap, etc.	Sleeping bag
Alarm clock	Backpack for school books
Phone Calling Cards	Credit /Debit Card Issued by a US Bank

Clothing to bring:

Casual clothes for school	Raincoat
Winter coat, hat, and gloves	Work clothes (jeans, sweatshirt, gloves)
Long underwear	Dress up clothes
Warm boots and socks	Shoes for hockey or soccer
Hiking boots	

Students may not wear clothing that is sexually explicit, that refers to or supports violence, tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs. Please mark belongings with permanent marker, or iron-on or sewn-in name tapes.

Laundry: Each dorm has coin-operated washers and dryers for student use.

Optional things to bring:

DO NOT BRING:

- Car or motorcycle
- TV, VCR, DVD player
- Space heaters or air conditioners
- Plug adapters
- Computer or video games rated "Mature (17+)" or "Adults Only"
- Posters, clothing or other items that are sexually suggestive or that support tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs or violence
- Lighters, matches, incense, candles
- Black lights, Christmas lights, halogen lamps
- Refrigerators or cooking appliances
